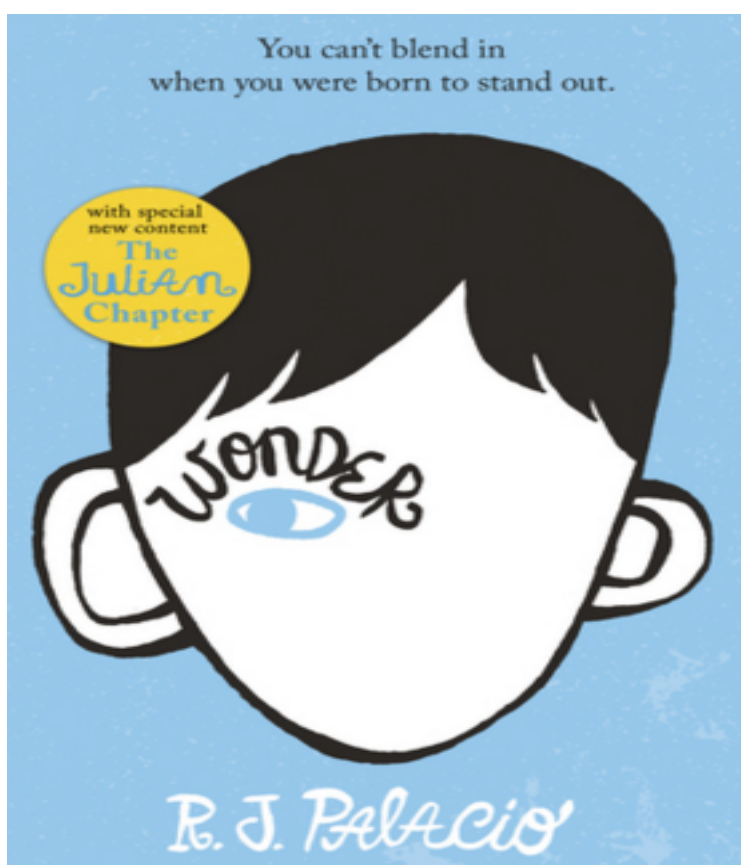

Annotation Expectations:

- ✓ **Every page** of the text is annotated.
- ✓ Annotation means both **underling** and writing **margin notes**.

Characterization Annotations:

- ✓ **Box** the name of any **new character** when he/she is introduced.
- ✓ **Underline** details about what the **character says, does, and feels**.
- ✓ **Write and box a character trait word in the margin**.
- ✓ **Underline** details about the **character's physical traits** (how he/she looks).
- ✓ **Write CH**  **in the margin** every time you notice the character changing and evolving.
- ✓ **Underline evidence** that shows **how and why he/she changed**.

Thematic Annotations:

- ✓ **Underline** evidence about the themes of **kindness, tolerance of differences, family, courage, friendship, popularity** in the text.
- ✓ **Write and box** the **theme word** in the margin.
- ✓ **Write margin notes about how these themes above influences the characters**.
